'The West Coast Masters Points Competition'

The competition that replaces the Roger Sutton competition is run as a points-score up to and including the races on the **18th March**

All starters will be given 5 points except for the race on 1st April. The best 14 performances to count, with the 15th being taken into account in the event of a tie. Place-points will also be awarded for current members only: 1st 10 pts, 2nd 8 pts, 3rd 7 pts, 4th 6 pts, 5th 5 pts, 6th 4 pts. The Time Trial on the 22 April will only count towards the Rose Preedy Road Points Competition.

The presentation of the competition awards will take place on 1st April.

NOTE: the following selection from AVCC Racing Rules and Regulations:

7. Mechanical Mishaps

- a) If a mechanical mishap occurs (a puncture, machine damage or a fall) approaching the finish of a race, the competitor may run with or carry the bicycle over the line and still qualify for a finishing prize.
- b) In a criterium race, if a mechanical mishap occurs (a puncture, machine damage or a fall), time out shall be allowed. The duration of the time out shall be determined by the race referee and the information conveyed to the competitors before the race. A competitor taking time out will not be allowed to gain advantage in terms of placing in the field when re-entering the race and must report to the referee to re-enter the race. Any rider who has been lapped by their own grade shall withdraw from the race at the showing of two laps to go board, or at the discretion of the referee. No rider shall take assistance from any grade other than their own. In the event of a breakaway lapping their grade, the sprint for minor places will be at the discretion of the referee.

8. General racing Rules

- c) At any time during a race that a sprint occurs the sprint rules shall apply whereby sprinting riders shall keep a straight line. Anyone veering, pushing or pulling, or in any other way causing dangerous obstruction shall be penalized.
- e) A competitor who is lapped or caught by another grade other than his/her own in a scratch race must not interfere with, or assist any other competitor nor participate in the sprints. The lapped rider must give way to the passing rider or group. It is a serious offence to sit in a bunch or share pace once lapped.
- f) Any competitor raising his or her arm or arms in a victory salute at the end of a race will be penalised.
